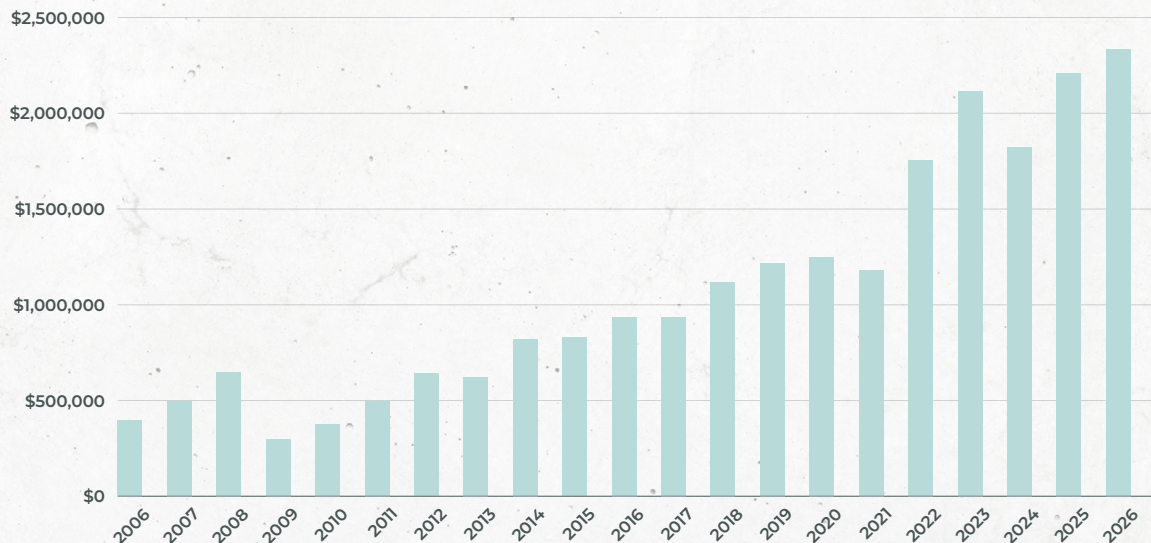

In 2026, the Concrete Industry Management program celebrates 30 years of preparing students for rewarding careers in the concrete industry. What began with two students has grown into a national program with more than 1,800 graduates serving in management roles across the industry.



Three decades of impact:

A program built by the industry

The need for CIM was first recognized in 1994, when industry leaders saw a growing demand for skilled professionals who could step into leadership roles. In response, the concrete industry partnered with Middle Tennessee State University to create a four-year degree designed specifically for concrete construction.

The CIM program launched in 1996 with its first two students. Today, it is available at California State University, Chico, Middle Tennessee State University, New Jersey Institute of Technology, South Dakota State University and Texas State University.

The curriculum combines business administration with hands-on concrete technology, giving students the technical, operational, communication and management skills needed to succeed.
